What drove your company to look into a collaborative business software? What were your motivations, and what were your business needs?

We wanted to take the focus away from trying to manage projects and focus more on the actual business of banking. Planview and a home-grown tool were used prior to Daptiv PPM and required much more effort.

What process did you go through to select a collaborative business software provider? What was your criteria?

We began to look into a new PPM option, but the process in choosing a tool was easy since the needs were clear:

- Clear dashboards that help drive a focus
- Simplicity. Nothing complicated, especially for end users. It had to be something that project managers could easily adopt.
